Sub.: **Release of Second Installment of Grants in Aid for Flexible Pool for communicable Diseases to Jammu & Kashmir under Revised National TB Control Programme during the year 2016-17**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of Rs.1,23,07,000/- (Rupees one crore twenty three lakh seven thousand only) to Jammu and Kashmir Divisions of State of J&K as Second Installment of Grants-in-Aid for Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases under Revised National TB Control Programme during the year 2016-17 as lump sum for undertaking various activities for implementation of RNTCP in the State. The release of this funds is subject to the condition that the State Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir would keep up to its commitments & will be strictly utilized as per the guidelines issued by the MoHFW, GoI and report within a month on compliance of transfer of funds to State Health Societies' Account. Audited Report and Utilization Certificate till the year 2015-16 have been received from the State Health Societies of Jammu & Kashmir and hence no UC is pending.

2. The above amount is in accordance with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance (Plan Finance Division) vide their O.M. No.10(1)-PF-I/76 dated 22nd January, 1977 and is to be paid in Cash.

3. The State shall not make any changes in allocation or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MoHFW, GoI.

4. The State shall ensure that 10% of its share based on release of funds by GoI is credited to appropriate accounts.

5. The State shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summery on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent Balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.

6. The Sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 206 to 215 of General Financial Rules, 2005.


