Dear BP.

As you are aware, improving health of children is one of the priority areas of National Health Mission. Diarrhoea contributes to around 10 percent underfive deaths in the country and most of these deaths are clustered around summer and monsoon seasons. Therefore, to effectively address this issue, Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF) is being implemented for the last three years, reaching out to millions of children, with essential life-saving commodity of ORS and Zinc Dispersible tablets along with awareness generation activities on preventive aspects, as childhood diarrhoeal diseases continue to be a major killer among under-five children in many states.

I am pleased to inform that with it has been decided to conduct IDCF this year from 12th June to 24th June, 2017. The main activities will include intensification of advocacy and awareness generation, strengthening service provision for diarrhoea case management, establishment of ORS-Zinc conrners, prepositioning of ORS by ASHA to households with under-five children and awareness generation activities for sanitation and hygiene.

The meaningful convergence between health department and other line departments like Education Department, Panchayati Raj institutions, Drinking Water and Sanitation, Tribal Welfare and Women and Child Development is central to the success of this initiative. Thus, you are requested to kindly accord top most priority to ensure best implementation of IDCF 2017 through convergence of efforts towards zero diarrhoea deaths. I am sure your leadership will add a lot of value to the programme.
