Project: National Program Management Agency (NPMA) For National Urban Health Mission (NUHM)

Expression of Interest

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) is responsible for implementation of various national health programs running in India in the areas of family welfare, public health, prevention and control of major communicable and non-communicable diseases.

MoHFW looks after the overall health situation in the country and is responsible for areas that have a wide impact on the aspects of public health and medical services in the country, e.g. population control, medical education, prevention of food adulteration, quality control in manufacture and sale of drugs, etc. and responsible for aspects relating to family welfare, especially in reproductive health and maternal health.

1. National Urban Health Mission (NUHM)

1.1 The Government of India launched the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) as a submission under the overarching National Health Mission (NHM) in May 2013 for providing equitable and quality primary health care services to the urban population with special focus on slum and vulnerable sections of the society. NUHM seeks to improve the health status by facilitating their access to quality primary healthcare. The launch of the NUHM shows the government's recognition of the need for focused attention on urban health. This Program seeks to facilitate equitable access to quality health care through strengthened public health systems, partnerships, and community participation, with active involvement of the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs). This will strengthen urban primary health care by establishing Urban Primary Health Centres (UPHCs) in all cities with a population of above 50,000 and district headquarters with a population of 30,000 and above. UPHCs would be linked with community outreach and referral services. The Program outcome indicators include increasing institutional delivery and full immunization coverage among children in urban areas; and achieving National Disease Control Program targets.

1.2 NUHM endeavours to achieve its goal through need based city specific urban health care system to meet the diverse health care needs of the urban poor and other vulnerable sections, institutional mechanism and management systems to meet the health-related

challenges of a rapidly growing urban population, partnership with community and local bodies for a more proactive involvement in planning, implementation, and monitoring of health indicators, availability of resources for providing essential primary health care to urban poor, and partnerships with NGOs/ civil societies, for profit and not for profit private health service providers and other stakeholders.

MoHFW intends to source Program Management Services to enhance human resources in Urban Health through a National Program Management Agency (NPMA) to manage, monitor and provide technical support to the NUHM.

2 Scope of Work

2.1 The NPMA would provide support to the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) and will provide strategic management advice to MoHFW on the basis of field experience and evidence for overall improvement in health indicators of urban poor. Further, it will provide technical and operational support to NUHM at National as well as State / UT level, including planning, coordination, monitoring and evaluation through monitoring visits to States / UTs, capacity development, and technical assessment of progress and necessary inputs on urban health service delivery matters, such as human resources, information technology for health services, Reproductive and Child Health (RCH), communicable and non-communicable diseases, quality assurance, community processes and private sector engagement. NPMA will analyse Financial Management Reports, Statement of Funds position and audit reports provided by the States/UTs. NPMA will also organize workshops, conferences, trainings, work studies and monitoring visits from time to time during the project period, as directed by MoHFW.

2.2 NPMA will work closely with other organization(s) under the administrative control of MoHFW such as NIHFW, NHSRC, donor partners including bilateral/ multilateral organisations to ensure smooth implementation & monitoring of the program activities. NPMA will also assist the MoHFW in tracking the progress and follow up with the stakeholders for the technical & functional issues in the implementation of NUHM. NPMA will suggest appropriate remedial timely action plan, document the evidences generated from the State/ UT visits, analyze the available data and information and generate actionable reports for decision making for NUHM program. NPMA will also undertake other activities, which will be assigned from time to time by NUHM Division of MoHFW. The appointed NPMA experts will be required to report to the NUHM Division in the format and periodicity as specified by MOHFW. The assignment will be contracted by MOHFW, Government of India, and it will ensure the support of counterpart staff / officials wherever necessary. The NPMA will also be responsible for arranging its own IT equipment and local office transportation.

3 Eligibility Criteria

- 3.1 The bidder should be a Company/ Society/ LLP registered in India under the relevant Act for a period of at least 5 years as on 31/12/2017. Bidder should attach the Certificate of Registration, Permanent Account Number (PAN), Service tax Registration/ GST Registration as per GST Law and Rules and Power of Attorney authorising the representative of the firm for participating in the Eol process. [(Annexure- 1, Form- 1 (a) & (b)]
- 3.2 The bidder should have an average annual turnover of not less than INR 30 Crores for the last three financial years (2013-14, 2014-15 & 2015-16). Bidder should attach Audited Financial Statements for the last three financial years duly certified by the statutory auditor clearly mentioning the average annual turnover for last three financial years. - 3.3 The bidder should have a positive Net Worth (Paid up Share Capital plus Free Reserves) as on 31st March 2016. (Annexure-1 Form-3)
- 3.4 The bidder should have executed at least one Project in Public Health/ Health [in Central Govt. / State Govt. / PSU/ NGO (including Development Partners)] with a minimum value of Rs 10 crores in last 5 years. Bidder should submit Work Order/ Award of Contract containing the contract value and Project Completion Certificate. (Annexure-1 Form-4).
- 3.5 The bidder should have at least 30 public health professionals on payroll of the firm on the date of submission of proposal. (Annexure-1 Form-5)
- 3.6 Bidder should not have defaulted in payment of statutory dues. (Annexure-1 Form-6)
- 3.7 The bidder should not have been blacklisted by any Government entity in India on the date of submission of bid. Litigation pending on the date of submission of bid, in any court of law, on account of blacklisting will amount to disqualification from bidding process. (Annexure-1 Form-7)
- 3.8 Bidder should not have withdrawn from similar government projects or should not have any contract termination from similar project with Government entities in the last 3 years. (Annexure-1 Form-8)
- 3.9 The bidder should submit the CV's of professionals proposed under various positions as mentioned in ToR for NPMA (Annexure 2); (Annexure-1 Form-9)

Note : All the forms and supporting documents are mandatory to be submitted with the Proposal.

4 Project period

The assignment will be for a period of 36 months and may be extended by the Ministry, on the same terms and conditions, if required.
