



Trainer's Checklist for Labour Room Visit

Before conducting the labour room visit, brief the learners about the objectives of this visit. Ask the learners to respect the privacy of the clients and maintain discipline during their labour room stay. The learners will be observing the safe delivery practices and also practice skills learned during the class room sessions during this visit if the clients are available and willing.

Divide the learners into small groups of seven to eight members so that normal labour room activities are not hampered and it does not get crowded during the visit.

Ensure that the learners have their skills demonstration checklists during the visit. Ask them to refer to the checklist during observation and practice in the labour room and make a note of their observation. Make sure that the learners understand that they are not supposed to intervene until and unless a life threatening emergency situation presents during their stay. Allocate sufficient time to each group to complete all their activities.

While one group is observing the labour room organization and safe delivery practices, other group practices triaging skills in the waiting area based on the situation.

At the end of the visit, thank the labour room staff for their co-operation and conclude the visit. Inform the learners that their doubts and questions will be discussed during the relevant sessions.
