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Executive Summary

IUCD Program

- MoHFW has extensively focused on strengthening post pregnancy contraception (PPIUCD and PAIUCD) in the past few years to meet the high unmet need for Family Planning in this period.
- In 2019-20, **57,53,421 IUCDs** were reported in HMIS against 56,56,904 IUCDs in 2018-19.
- **PPIUCD:**
 - Since the initiation of the programme, **over 10 million PPIUCDs** have been inserted across the country.
 - In 2019-20, **24,93,847 PPIUCD** insertions were reported which shows an **increase of 8.8% from previous year**.
 - **Total PPIUCD acceptance rate in the country is 16.5%. Tamil Nadu (39.22%), West Bengal (37.11%) and Haryana (29.64%) reported the highest acceptance for PPIUCD** in India. Among high focus states, Rajasthan (23%) showed the highest PPIUCD acceptance followed by Madhya Pradesh (19.2%). The 6 high focus states contribute to 47% of the entire PPIUCD insertions reported across the country.
- **PAIUCD:**
 - FP division has been revitalizing focus on post abortion contraception from last three years. Service providers have been trained and data elements were incorporated in HMIS in 2017-18.
 - In 2019-20, **91,016 PAIUCD insertions** were reported with the acceptance of 7%.
 - **The highest acceptance of PAIUCD has been reported by Odisha (13.24%) followed by Assam (12.66%) and Karnataka (11.62%)**

Sterilization Services:

- The reported number of sterilisations decreased to **33,58,273 in 2019-20 from 35,42,434 in 2018-19**, showing a decline of 5%. This may be attributed to the substantial increase in Long acting reversible methods of contraception (IUCD insertions and Injectable MPA).
- **Interval female sterilization contributes close to 75% of the total sterilizations** followed by postpartum sterilization (21.53%) and post abortion sterilization (1.81%). Male sterilization contributes to only 1.62% of total sterilizations.
- The number of sterilizations has increased in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Karnataka, Telangana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Puducherry, and Lakshadweep.
- Of the remaining states which reflect a decline, the steepest decline has been in Andhra Pradesh followed by Gujarat.
- **Male sterilization has witnessed a 9% increase in 2019-20 as compared to last year.** The maximum increase in number of male sterilizations have been reported in Uttar Pradesh (46% increase) followed by Madhya Pradesh (49% increase).

- In terms of absolute numbers, Maharashtra has reported the highest number of male sterilizations (9042), followed by Chhattisgarh (6757) and Uttar Pradesh (5693), while Chhattisgarh reports the highest share of male sterilization (10.12%).
- **Share of Post-partum sterilizations** (out of total female sterilization) has remained almost static from **21.89% in 2018-19 to 21.7% in 2019-20.**
- **60,796 Post-abortion sterilizations were reported in 2019-20 (1.8% of total sterilizations)**

Injectable MPA- Antara Program

- Injectable Contraceptive MPA was introduced in the public health system in 2017-19 alongside Centchroman (Chhaya Pills)
- A total of **19,40,523 doses** of Injectable MPA were administered in 2019-20 against 9,93,535 doses in 2018-19.
- **Bihar reported the maximum number of doses of Injectable MPA(3,49,690)** followed by Uttar Pradesh (3,44,205), West Bengal (2,81,003) and Rajasthan (2,20,279).

Family Planning Schemes

- **Home Delivery of Contraceptives (HDC):**
 - Nearly **11 crores pieces of Condoms, 1.79 crores COC cycles, 38.31 lakh ECPs and 49 lakh Centchroman strips have been distributed** under the scheme by around **8.8lakhs ASHAs** in 2019-20. The highest distribution of condoms has been reported by Manipur (97.7%) followed by Uttarakhand (89 %), Arunachal Pradesh (85.9%) and Delhi(84.7%).
 - Manipur (93.3%), West Bengal (84.7%),Delhi (83.50%) are three highest states for distribution of COCs.
 - Manipur (95.7%) has reported the maximum distribution of ECPS followed by Rajasthan (75.6 %) and Delhi (73.1%).
 - Highest distribution of Chhaya (Centchroman) was reported by Delhi (78.0 %) followed by West Bengal (77.7%) and Goa (68.1 %).
- **Scheme of Ensuring spacing at Birth (ESB):**
 - In 2019-20 81.7 % claims have been cleared under ESB 3 (sterilization after 1st or 2nd child), 92% of claims have been cleared under ESB 2 (spacing of 3 yrs between 1st and 2nd child), and 63.2% claims have been cleared under ESB 1 (spacing of 2 yrs between marriage and birth of first child).
- **Pregnancy Testing Kit Scheme:**
 - In 2019-20, 61.7% utilization of the pregnancy testing kits has been reported under the **Pregnancy Testing Kit (PTK) Scheme**. 53% of this is being utilized at facility level (DH/SDH/CHC/PHC).

Family Planning Logistics Management Information System (FP-LMIS)

FP-LMIS is a web, mobile and SMS based application developed to manage supply chain operations, reduce the supply-service disparities and to regulate the flow of family planning commodities from national level to the end user.

- State level trainings have been completed in 33 States/UTs.
- 9 out of 36 State/UTs (Delhi, Goa, Chandigarh, Daman & Diu, Gujarat, Meghalaya, Puducherry, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh) have completed the training up to ASHA level while 22 have completed district level trainings.
- 15 State/UTs (Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal) have initiated their facility level trainings.
- All State/UTs have submitted their annual demand for the year 2020-21 and interim indents through FP-LMIS.
- All GMSDs and Suppliers use FP-LMIS for delivery of contraceptives to the States based on the Purchase Order and Release Order of MoHFW.
- 90% district warehouses, 77% CHCs, 60% PHCs, 76% DHs, 52% SDHs, 26% Sub Centres and 9% ASHAs submitted their indents through FPLMIS during the year 19-20.

Mission Parivar Vikas

- The scheme has been rolled out in all districts. Rajasthan has neither budgeted nor implemented the NayiPehl Kit scheme.
- In 2019-20, 4.26 lakh NayiPehl kits were distributed across 6 states and 1.84 lakh Saas Bahu Sammelans were organized in 7 MPV states.
- A total 9.03 lakh sterilisations were performed during the four MPV fortnights in 2019-20. The MPV districts contribute to almost 60% of the sterilizations in these MPV states.
- With 8.43 lakh injectable doses administered in MPV districts in 2019-20, they contribute to 43% of the total Injectable MPA doses administered in the country in 2019-20.
- 80% of the facilities in MPV districts have installed Condom Boxes.

Other Activities

- **World Population Day 2019** was celebrated on July 11th and ‘Population Stabilisation Fortnight’ was celebrated across states from 11th to 24th July. Around 1.52 lakh sterilizations and 3.1 lakh IUCDs were reported in WPD fortnight in 2019-20.
- **For the promotion of Male Participation in Family Planning**, Vasectomy fortnight was celebrated from 21st Nov to 4th Dec 2019. 11,446 vasectomies were reported in 2019 as against 8,195 in 2018. Chhattisgarh was the highest performing state with 1809 vasectomies reported during the fortnight, followed by Assam (1508) and Telangana (1110).
- All state Program Implementation Plans for 2019-20 were appraised and ROPs issued based on the approvals during the NPCC meetings.
- Regular monitoring visits and workshops were conducted across states.


1. IUCDSERVICES:

In 2019-20, **57,53,421** IUCDs were reported in HMIS against 56,56,904 IUCDs in 2018-19.

The overall share of PPIUCD is 43% and that of PAIUCD is 2% in 2019-20.

The share of post pregnancy IUCD has increased from 36.6% to 45% from 2017-18 to 2019-20.


IUCD performance- 2019-20



1.1 PPIUCD (Post-Partum IUCD):


- Since the initiation of the programme, **over 1 Crore PPIUCDs** have been inserted across the country.
- In 2019-20, **24,93,847 PPIUCD insertions** were reported which shows an **increase of 8.8%** from previous year.
- The **acceptance of PPIUCD** is also on the rise and has almost doubled in last four years with **16.5%** acceptance (out of public health institutional deliveries) reported in 2019-20 (against 8.1% reported in 2015-16)

IUCD performance




State wise status of PPIUCD:

In 2019-20, **West Bengal (3.69 lakh)** reported the highest number of PPIUCD insertions followed by Uttar Pradesh (3.54 lakh) and Rajasthan (2.62 lakh).




PPIUCD acceptance Rate: Tamil Nadu (39.2%), West Bengal (37.1%) and Haryana (29.64%) reported the highest acceptance for PPIUCD while states like Telangana (2.0%) and Andhra Pradesh (1.76%) reported low PPIUCD acceptance rate.




PPIUCD performance in 6 high focus states:


- Total PPIUCD insertions in 2019-20 - 11 lakhs, which contributes to 47% of the entire PPIUCD insertions reported across the country.
- Among the 6 high focus states Rajasthan (23%) and MP (19.2%) reported highest PPIUCD acceptance while Bihar (11%) and UP (12.1%) shows lowest acceptance percentage.
- The PPIUCD acceptance has been almost static in all high focus states from the last year.



1.2 PAIUCD (Post Abortion IUCD):


- 91,016 PAIUCD insertions were reported in 2019-20 with Assam reporting highest PAIUCD insertions (15,610) followed by West Bengal (9,836) and Maharashtra (9,044).
- PAIUCD acceptance rate: PAIUCD acceptance rate for India in the year 2019-20 was 7.04% (out of the total abortions reported). Among the states, the highest acceptance of PAIUCD has been reported by Odisha (13.2%) followed by Assam (12.7%) and Karnataka (11.6%).






2. STERILIZATION SERVICES:

- In 2019-20 nearly **33.04 lakhs** female sterilization and **54,239** male sterilizations were reportedly performed in the country, which sums up to a total of **33.58 lakh sterilizations**(5% less than the previous year). This may be attributed to the substantial increase in Long acting reversible methods of contraception (IUCD insertions and Injectable MPA).
- Interval female sterilization contributes close to 75% of the total sterilizations** followed by postpartum sterilization (21.5%) and post abortion sterilization (1.8%). Male sterilization contributes to 1.6% of total sterilizations.



2.1 Total Sterilization- State wise status:

- In terms of sterilization numbers, **Bihar reported the highest number of sterilization cases followed by Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh.** The graph below shows the highest performing states in India.




- All states except Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura, Karnataka, Telangana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Puducherry, and Lakshadweep have shown decline in sterilization numbers from previous year (2018-19). **The highest decline in terms of number was reported in Andhra Pradesh (26%)followed by Uttarakhand (20%).**Table below shows the state wise decline.


2.2 Male Sterilization:

- Owing to the huge efforts, Male sterilization witnessed a **9% increase in 2019-20** as compared to last year
- The **highest number of male sterilization has been reported by Maharashtra (9042), Chhattisgarh (6757) and Uttar Pradesh (5693).**
- However in terms of overall share, **Chhattisgarh reports highest share (10.1%) followed by Himachal Pradesh (7.0%).**
- 15 States/ UTs have shown an increase in the trend of male sterilization.** The maximum increase in number of male sterilizations have been reported in Uttar Pradesh (46% increase) followed by Madhya Pradesh (49% increase).



2.3 Post-partum Sterilization:

- The share of postpartum sterilization (out of total female sterilization) decreased slightly from 21.9% in 2018-19 to 21.7% in 2019-20. The graph below highlights the states having PPS share more than the National average in 2019-20. Among the major states, **Tamil Nadu (76.9%) has the highest share of PPS followed by Kerala (75.4%), West Bengal (49.58%) and Assam (43.16%)**




2.3.1 PPS- Scenario of 6 High focus States:

- Share of postpartum sterilization (out of total female sterilization) increased in Jharkhand (2.3%), Bihar (0.8) and Uttar Pradesh (0.5%) while it remained stagnant in Rajasthan.
- In terms of numbers, Uttar Pradesh reports the highest increase followed by Bihar and Jharkhand.

2.4 Post Abortion Sterilization:

- In 2019-20, **60,796 post abortion sterilizations were reported, which is 1.8% of the total sterilization in the country.**
- **Tamil Nadu reports the highest number of post abortion sterilizations** in the country (**12,977**) followed by Maharashtra (11,606) and Uttar Pradesh (6,982).



2.5 Quality Sterilization Services:

Ensuring adherence to quality standards is one of the prime strategies under Family Planning Program.



Last few years has witnessed augmented efforts for improving quality in sterilization service provision. Since 2014, detailed state and district wise reviews and orientations are being undertaken every year by the FP Division.

Each year, FP division came up with different themes for this workshop. However, the structure of workshop is such that it covers all the aspects of quality.



2.6 Family Planning Indemnity Scheme:

- **Sterilization Complications:** There were 83 claims of complications following sterilization reported from states in 2019-20 as against 79 in 2018-19. Highest numbers of claims for complications are 34 from Maharashtra and 21 cases from Tripura. The rate of complications following sterilizations (per one lakh sterilization) is 2.5 in 2019-20.
- **Death Attributable to Sterilization:** The death rate per lakh sterilization is 2.2 in 2019-20 with 75 deaths reported across the country. Maharashtra reports highest number of deaths attributable to sterilization.
- In terms of death rate per lakh sterilization 8 states are above National average. Among large states Assam, Jharkhand and Maharashtra reports high death rates.




- **Sterilization Failure:** 4895 failure claims have been reported in 2019-20 with highest number of failures reported by Rajasthan followed by Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.



2.6.2 Trend for death, complication and failure:


Various steps have been undertaken by Government of India post mishaps and violations of SOPs to strengthen the service delivery under family planning in compliance with Hon'ble Supreme Court directives.

It is observed that decline of 0.15 points and 20.4 points been observed for death and failure rates attributable to sterilization from its preceding year respectively.




3. INJECTABLE MPA (ANTARA PROGRAMME)

A total of 19.40 lakh doses of injectable MPA were administered all over the country in 2019-20 under Antara Program against 9.93 lakh doses in 2018-19, which is a 95% increase.



3.1 State wise performance:

Bihar has reported the maximum number of doses of Injectable MPA in 2019-20 (3.50 lakh) followed by Uttar Pradesh (3.44 lakh), West Bengal (2.81 lakh), Rajasthan (2.20 lakh), and Madhya Pradesh (1.24 lakh).



4. FAMILY PLANNING SCHEMES


4.1 Scheme of Home Delivery of Contraceptives (HDC)

As per reports received, the distribution of Condoms/COCs/ECPs/ Centchroman in 2019-20 is as follows:

4.1.1 Condoms

The highest distribution of condoms has been reported by Manipur (97.7%) followed by Uttarakhand (89.0%), Arunachal Pradesh (85.9%), Delhi (84.7%), Goa (83.4%) and West Bengal (81.3%)



The cumulative figures of condom distributed for all the reported states show that almost **11.77crore pieces of condoms** have been distributed under the ASHA scheme with a **total utilization of 49.7%**.

4.1.2 Combined Oral Contraceptive Pills

All over India **1.79 crores COC cycles** have been distributed under HDC (**46% distribution**)2019-20.



In the supportive supervision visits ASHAs displayed fair knowledge of OCP usage. However medical screening of the clients using OCPs for the first time is a concern in high focus states.

4.1.3 Emergency Contraceptive Pills

38.31 lakhs ECPs have been distributed under HDC in 2019-20 (35.7% distribution). Bihar, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam, Andaman, Puducherry, Maharashtra and Keralahas reported distribution of ECPs at less than 30%.



4.1.4 Centchroman


In 2019-20, all over India **49.17lakh strips has been distributed by field functionaries with 45.6% distribution.** Karnataka, Odisha, Punjab, Manipur, Kerala, Puducherry, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Assam, Tamil Nadu, Sikkim and Maharashtra have reported distribution less than 30%.

4.2 Scheme of Ensuring spacing at Birth (ESB)


- As per 2019-20 report maximum claims were received under ESB component 1.
- Field level observations and interaction with ASHAs indicate that the scheme is operational in all the earmarked states.
- 81.7% of claims have been cleared under ESB 3 (sterilization after 1st or 2nd child), 92% claims have been cleared under ESB 2 (spacing of 3 yrs between 1st and 2nd child) and 63.2% claims have been cleared under ESB 1 (spacing of 2 yrs between marriage and birth of first child).**



4.3 Scheme of Pregnancy Testing Kits (PTK):

The overall PTK utilization stands at **61.7%.**


Out of the total PTKs utilized, 53% are being utilized at DH/SDH/CHC/PHC level. 47% of



PTKs are being distributed at the field level either through ASHA or through Subcenter.

- Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, Telangana, West Bengal and Delhi has reported utilisation of PTK more than 70 %.

5. FAMILY PLANNING LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (FP-LMIS)

As per the reports received from the states;

5.1 Training status

- State level trainings have been completed in 32 State/UTs. State trainings on FP-LMIS have not been initiated in UTs like DNH, Lakshadweep, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Ladakh.
- District warehouse trainings has been completed in 708 districts (99.5%).
- District level trainings have been completed in 22 states (Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttarakhand and West Bengal) while in 2 States (Andhra Pradesh and Sikkim) district level trainings have been initiated.
- 15 State/UTs (Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Nagaland, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal) have initiated their facility level trainings. This includes 1,491 District level facilities, 3,094 CHC, 14,505 PHC and 90,368 SC.


5.2 Operation status

State level operationalization:

- All State/UTs have submitted their annual demand for the year 2020-21 and interim indents through FP-LMIS.
- All GMSDs and Suppliers used FP-LMIS for delivery of contraceptives to the State/UTs based on the Purchase Orders and Release Orders of MoHFW in 2019-20.

District level operationalization:

- Out of a total of 712 districts, trainings have been completed in 708 districts (99.5%), online indenting by 641 districts (90 %), and online issuance by 608 districts (85%)
- 90% district warehouses, 77% CHCs, 60% PHCs, 76% DHs, 52% SDHs, 26% Sub Centers and 9% ASHAs have submitted their indent through FPLMIS during the year 2019-20.




6. MISSION PARIVAR VIKAS


Mission Parivar Vikas(MPV) was envisaged to improve access to contraceptives and Family Planning services across 146 High Fertility Districts in 7 high focus States.

6.1 Roll out of injectable services:

- MPA services roll out has shown a consistent increase at all level of facilities since inception of the program. 100% DH, 96% CHC, 52% PHC and 30%SC are functional for MPA services.
- MPV districts contribute 43.5% share to total MPA doses administered in the country in 2019-20. In 2019-20, 8,43,713 doses were administered in 146 MPV districts as against 5,19,364 in 2018-19.




Year wise performance of MPV districts under Antara program




- Maximum percentage increase has been witnessed in Jharkhand followed by Assam.
- With the expansion of Antara program upto SC level in non MPV districts the performance of MPA has more than doubled (from 4,74,171 doses in 2018-19 to 10,96,810 doses in 2019-20).

6.2 Augmentation of PPIUCD services:


- 16.2 lakh IUCD insertions are reported in 2019-20 in MPV districts as compared to 15.2 in 2018-19 (increase of 7%)**
- PPIUCD:**The overall PPIUCD acceptance rate has increased from 11.7% in 2018-19 to 12% in 2019-20.
- 7,22,396 PPIUCD were reported in 2019-20 as against 5,60,883 (28.8% increase)**
- Out of 5151 delivery points in MPV districts 3347 are providing PPIUCD services (65% facilities).



State wise delivery points providing PPIUCD services





- **PAIUCD**: PAIUCD has been reported to **increase by 36.3% in 2019-20** (from 9863 in 2018-19 to 13441 in 2019-20)
- There is an increase in PAIUCD acceptance 8.3% (2019-2020) as compared to 6.1% in 2018-19.
- MPV districts contribute higher share for IUCD services as compared to Non MPV districts



6.3 Augmentation of sterilization services

- 9,03,189 sterilization has been reported in 2019-20 as against 8,93,920 in 2018-19.
- Total sterilization in these 7 states has been largely contributed by MPV districts 61.1 % as compared to Non MPV (38.9%).
- **Male sterilization** has been showing a steady increase in all MPV districts (43% increase from 2017-18 to 2019-20).
- State wise performance shows that all states except Rajasthan has shown an increase in male sterilization with maximum increase in Assam followed by Chhattisgarh.
- **Overall share of male sterilization out of total sterilization** has increased from 0.9% in 2017-18 to 1.18% in 2018-19 and further to 1.26% in 2019-20.
- **MPV districts in Chhattisgarh has shown highest share of male sterilization**
- **Female Sterilization** has also shown a steady increase from 2017-18 to 2019-20 (1.73% increase) (2017-18- 8.76 lakh; 2018-19- 8.83 lakh; 2019-20- 8.92 lakh)
- **Post-pregnancy sterilization**: MPV districts reported 56,430 PPS and 8,900 PAS in 2019-20 as against 52,600 and 7,847 in 2018-19 (7.3% increase in PPS and 13.4% increase in PAS)

6.4 Condom boxes at strategic locations


- 80% facilities (36,686 facilities in 2019-20 as against 30,565 facilities in 2018-19) in MPV districts have installed Condom boxes.
- 1.8 crore pieces of condoms have been distributed through condom boxes in 2019-20 as against 2.03 Crore in 2018-19.

6.5 Monitoring Structure

- All MPV States/Districts reported to formulate State/District Program Implementation Body (SPIB/DPIB) for monitoring and planning of MPV activities.
- All MPV states and districts have enthusiastically conducted district and block level advocacy meetings this year as well.
- 1007 District and 7060 block level meetings were conducted in 2019-20 as against 727 and 4511 in 2018-19.

6.6 NayiPahel Kit- An Informative FP kit for Newly Weds:

- In 2019-20, ASHAs distributed 4,26,632 NayiPehl Kits in MPV districts of 6 states.
- Rajasthan have not budgeted for NayiPahel Kits under PIP and activity is not implemented through any other budget source


State wise NP Kits distribution

7. HIGHLIGHTS OF KEY ACTIVITIES IN 2019-20:

7.1 World population Day and Workshop 2019

The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare celebrated the World Population Fortnight from 27th June – 24th July 2019 and conducted the National workshop on World Population day on 11th July 2019. The event was organised across all the states through events spanning till the block level.

7.1.1 National Workshop:

The National level workshop on World Population Day was celebrated at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi. Hon'ble Union Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan and in the sovereign presence of Hon'ble Minister of State Shri. Ashwini Kumar Choubey.



The theme for World Population Day 2019 was

“परिवारनियोजनसेनिभाएँजिम्मेदारी माँ और बच्चे के स्वास्थ्य की पूरी तैयारी”

World Population Day 2019 marked the 25th year of India's commitment at the International Conference on Population & Development held at Cairo. In accordance with this, the theme for this year's national work shop was “ICPD@25 – Leveraging Partnerships.” New Television Commercials developed to promote increase uptake of new contraceptives were launched and panel discussions with eminent speakers on relevant topics around the theme of the workshop were conducted.

Key Findings

- WPD fortnight has resulted in breaking the country's seasonal phenomenon of conducting Family Planning services specially sterilizations only in the winter months.
- **Antara programme** has gained a lot of momentum in a short span of time which is evident by the enthusiastic uptake and demand garnered across the states. The method witnessed an **increase of over 200% in WPD 2019 from WPD 2018**. The States of Uttar Pradesh (65,292), West Bengal (51,753), Bihar (35,121) and Assam (20,396) reported highest number of Contraceptive Injectable MPA doses administration.
- **PPIUCD** has been witnessing a noticeable increase of 15%- 20% in its utilization every year (85,756 in 2017, 1,01,908 in 2018 and 1,17,355 in 2019)
- WPD 2019 also saw an **increase by 37% in male sterilization** (7366) as compared to 5363 in 2018. The states of Chhattisgarh (1777), Uttar Pradesh (1670), West Bengal (1007) and Bihar (653) have reported highest number of male sterilizations during WPD 2019.
- The states organized advocacy and IEC campaigns right down to the village level by involving PRIs, Elected Representatives, NGOs and other local bodies which has provided a thrust for adoption of FP services and resulted in creating an enabling environment.
- This WPD saw a great momentum among the masses regarding Family planning through Saas Bahu Samelans, which not only involved the women of the houses but also brought every member of the village together.

7.2 Vasectomy Fortnight

Vasectomy Fortnight was observed in the entire country and the celebration spanned over the months of November-December 2019. The fortnight was split into a Mobilization/Sensitization phase followed by a Service Delivery phase.

The “Mobilisation Phase” was organised between 21st November to 27th November, 2019; followed by the “Service Delivery Phase” organised between 28th November - 4th December, 2019.

The theme for vasectomy fortnight this year was:


“Purushonki ab haibaari – ParivaarNiyojan Mein Bhaagidari”

7.2.1 Vasectomy Fortnight:

The overall performance during the fortnight (21st Nov-4th Dec) improved from previous year. The details are as follows:-

The fortnight served as an opportunity to promote the entire family planning programmatic strategies. 11446 vasectomies were done during the fortnight in 2019, which is an increase of 39.6% from previous year. The number of condom boxes installed increased by 50%, while the condom pieces distributed during the fortnight has shown an increase of 3% percent. Chhattisgarh was the highest performing state with 1809 vasectomies reported during the fortnight, followed by Assam (1508) and Telangana (1110).



West Bengal reported the highest number of condom pieces distribution (12,06,291) followed by Bihar (11,31,919), Uttar Pradesh (9,32,036) and Madhya Pradesh (6,17,325).

Close to 50% of the vasectomies reported during the fortnight are from 7 MPV states (Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Assam). Among these 7 MPV states, highest share of vasectomies is from Chhattisgarh (1809) followed by Assam (1508).
