**Subject: Release of Funds of Grants-in-Aid to UT of Delhi under Flexible Pool for Non-Communicable Disease for the year 2018-19-Sanction Reg.**

Sir,

In supersession of earlier sanction order of even number dated 26.02.2019, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of to the payment of **Rs.21,40,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakh and Forty Thousand Only)** to the UT of Delhi towards First Installment of Grants-in-Aid under **Flexible Pool for Non-Communicable Disease** for creation of Capital Assets during 2018-19.

2. The above amount is in accordance with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance (Plan Finance Division) vide their O.M. No.10(1)-PF-I/76 dated 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 1977 and is to be paid in Cash.
3. The UT shall not make any changes in allocations or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MoHFW, GoI.
4. The UT shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summary on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/ SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
5. The UT shall ensure that 40% of its share based on release of funds by GOI is credited to appropriate accounts.
6. Grant in-Aid shall be used for the purpose for which sanction is given. An annual utilization certificate (in Form **GFR 12C**) shall be furnished that the contribution has been utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.
7. The Audited Utilization Certificates towards releases made during the year 2017-18 from the UT of Delhi have been received.
8. The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 228 to 245 of General Financial Rules, 2017.
9. The expenditure covered by this sanction will be met from the funds provided under Major Head = 3602- Grants-in-aid to Union Territory with Legislature (Major Head); 06101 - Central Assistance/Share (Minor Head); 03- National Rural Health Mission; 03.04- Flexible Pool for Non-Communicable Diseases; 03.04.35 - Grants for Creation of Capital Assets under Demand No.42 – Health & Family Welfare during 2018-19.
