- The UTs shall not make any changes in allocation or re-appropriations among different components/activities without approval of the MoHFW, GoI.
- The UTs shall follow all the financial management systems under NHM and shall submit Audit Reports, Utilization Certificates, Quarterly Summery on Concurrent Audit, FMRs/SOEs and Statement of Funds Position, showing unspent Balances, funds released as advances, interest earned on unspent balance as and when due.
- The UTs shall ensure that 40% of its share based on release of funds by GOI is credited to appropriate accounts..
- Grant in-Aid shall be used for the purpose for which the sanction is given. A annual utilization certificate (in Form **GFR 12C**) shall be furnished that the contribution has been utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.
- The Audited Utilization Certificates towards releases made during the year 2017-18 from the UT have been received.

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
8. The sanction order is being issued in accordance with Rule 228 to 245 of General Financial Rules, 2017.
