

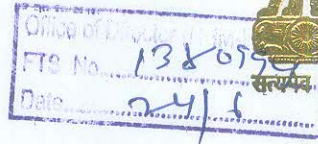

National Viral Hepatitis Control Programme (NVHCP) is a new programme included under the Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases of National Health Mission. Central allocation and financial approvals for the FY 2019-20 under this programme have already been conveyed to the States/UTs.

2. The Ministry had issued guidelines in 2014 for opening of bank account for NHM funds vide D.O.No. G-27017/4/2013-NRHM(F) dated 10th March, 2014 (copy enclosed). Accordingly, the States/UTs are required to open a dedicated sub bank account for NVHCP at State as well as District level under Group Bank account having facility of linked sub-account for NDCPs flexible Pool.

3. It is therefore requested that the State Health Societies and District Health Societies accordingly open a separate sub-bank account for NVHCP under the Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases under intimation to this Ministry on priority

Dear *All,*

This is in continuation of Ministry's earlier D.O. letter of even number dated 23rd January, 2012 containing the detailed guidelines for opening and operating the Single Group Bank Account and linked sub accounts for Programmes/Schemes covered under NRHM.

2 You may be aware that to cater to primary health care needs of urban population, particularly the poor and vulnerable sections amongst them, NUHM has been launched under an over arching umbrella of National Health Mission. Secondly, to address the emerging challenge of growing disease burden of Non Communicable Diseases (NCDs), a newly constituted NCD flexi -pool has been introduced under the National Health Mission. All interventions up to District Hospital level and below for Non-Communicable Disease Programmes will now be funded through this NCD flexi-pool under NHM.

3. In view of the above, the hierarchy structure of Group Accounts under NHM will need to be changed. Now, in the hierarchy of Group Accounts under NHM, there will be one (1) main account for NHM in the SHS. Under this main account there will be four (4) sub Accounts of four major flexible pools in the first layer of hierarchy structure and these are (i) NRHM-RCH Flexible Pool (ii) NUHM Flexible Pool (iii) Flexible Pool for Communicable Diseases and (iv) Flexible Pool for Non Communicable Diseases. Under these Flexible Pools (i.e. under 1st layer) there will be 2nd level of Sub Accounts in respect of different schemes viz. RCH Flexible Pool, Mission Flexible Pool, Routine Immunisation, Pulse Polio Immunisation under the NRHM-RCH Flexible Pool etc. The same set of Group Accounts need to be replicated up to DHS level. However, at Block level as the quantum of funds is lesser, so a single account for NHM funds may be maintained. There will be altogether Nineteen (19) Sub Accounts (4 sub accounts at 1st layer and 15 sub accounts at 2nd layer. I am enclosing herewith the fund flow diagram in order to understand the flow of funds.


4. These are the accounts that need to be maintained irrespective of the way of fund transfer from the Ministry to the States.

5. SHS should open separate account (s) for Non-NHM funds that they receive under other schemes from Union/State Government and from development partners.

6. I would, therefore, request that as per the above directions consolidated NHM Bank account be made operational latest by 25th March, 2014 and a report indicating the new bank sub-account numbers may be submitted to the Ministry at the earliest.

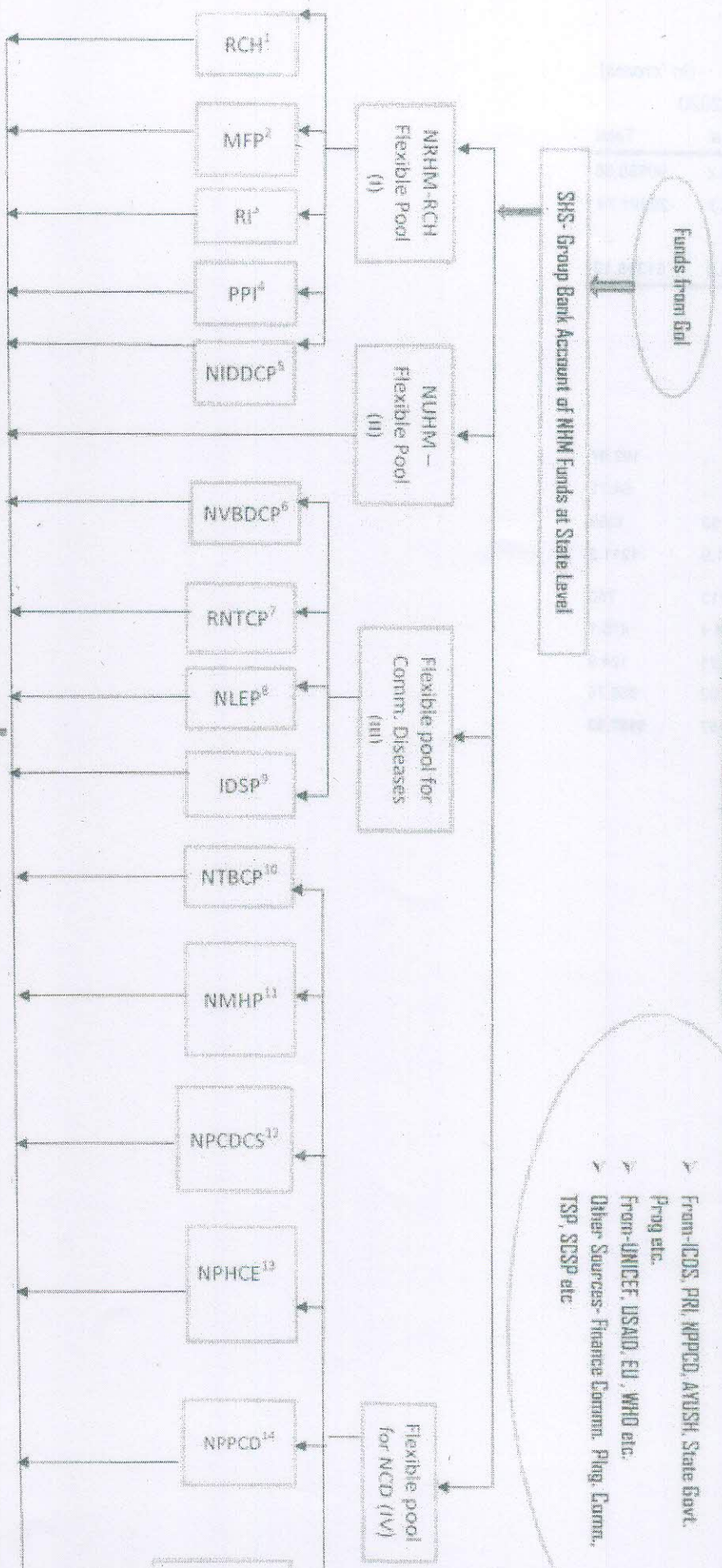

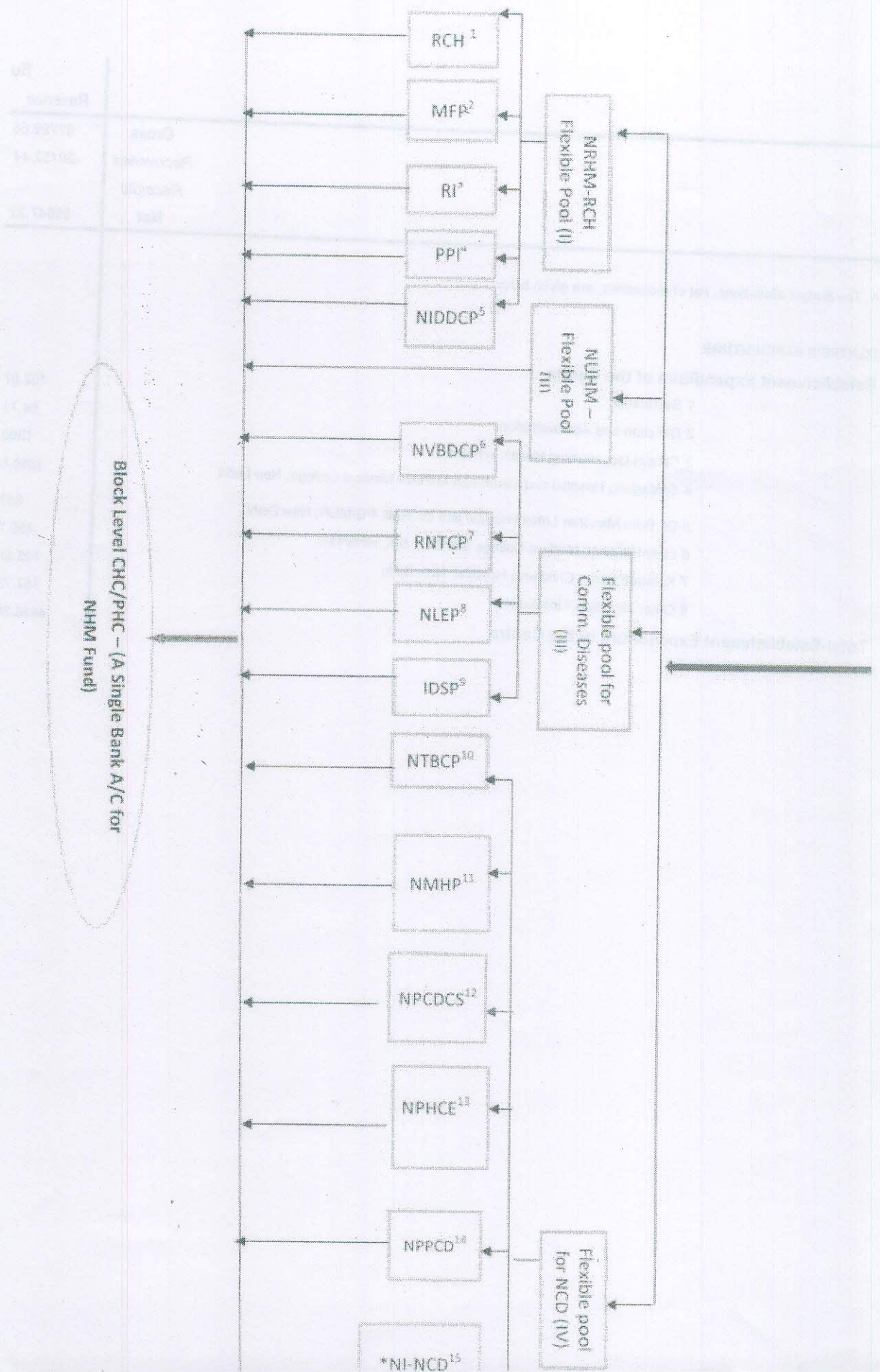
