Dear Prof. Thappa,

You may be aware that the Government has rolled out Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme under National Health Mission following announcement in Union budget with the objective to ensure access to dialysis services in district hospitals. The States /UTs are being supported for provision of dialysis services to poor. States/UTs have the option to operationalise in PPP mode or in house. To facilitate States such as Meghalaya, Ministry has allocated free dialysis machines offered by Fairfax India Charitable Foundation. The State of Meghalaya has not been able to find a suitable bidder despite repeated efforts, State has now decided to pursue the same in an in-house mode.

In this regard, we seek your help and request our doctors/nurses be trained in NEIGRIMS.

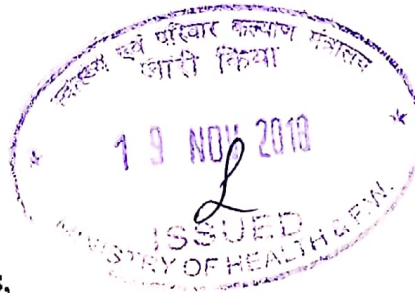
Given that this is also one of the key initiatives of the Central Government, may I request you to kindly organise for their training at the earliest. I look forward to an early and positive response.
