Dear Sir/Madam.

As you are aware, we are embarking on a population based programme for screening, control and prevention of Non Communicable Diseases. The States have already been communicated a list of districts and cities (at Annexure I) in which this programme will be launched in the first phase; i.e before March 31, 2017. In order to improve the motivation of the ASHAs and ANMs to undertake the tasks of population based screening programme in urban areas, and to serve as a role models, may I suggest that as a priority, ASHAs and ANMs in the ward/city be referred to a teaching hospital or district hospital so that they may themselves undergo screening for all five common conditions, i.e. measurement of blood pressure, blood glucose, clinical breast examination, oral visual examination and visual Inspection by Acetic Acid.

The Medical Officer/Public Health Manager of U-PHCs should contact the nearest health facility that offers screening for all five conditions. Alternatively, the U-PHCs located in urban areas can also provide services for screening of all 5 conditions mentioned above. Local level planning for fixing the day and timing for screening will be required. Over the next two months, the ANMs and ASHAs should be motivated to undergo screening. Also, they need to be provided with the appropriate referral and treatment depending upon the outcome of the screening.

ANMs and ASHAs need to be oriented to the programme, so that they understand clearly the need for such screening and their own tasks vis a vis the community.

This initiative will serve as a measure to build the confidence of our frontline workers in urban areas in the referral facilities. The State NPCDCS officers and ASHA nodal officers have already been oriented to the programme. National and State trainers for ANM and ASHA have also been trained.
